

Installing MUMS on Windows 7 Workstation

Collecting Old Information and Data:

- On existing workstation, copy c:\mt2000\system\license.db file to server or thumb drive so it can be copied to same location on new workstation after doing MUMS install.
- Enter MUMS on existing station and write down what it says at the bottom of the screen opposite Tables: (such as z:\mt2000\tables or m:\tables)
- On Windows Menu, look for MUMS2000 and click on BDE Config
 - Click on Configuration tab
 - Double click, Configuration, Drives, Native
 - Single click Paradox
 - Write down what it says for NET DIR on the right such as z:\mt2000 or m:\

Installing on new workstation:

- Install MUMS as single user computer and take all of the defaults.
- Make sure you have same mapped drive as any existing workstation
- Copy your saved License.db to c:\mt2000\system folder.
- Double click (to edit) c:\mt2000\system\mums2000.ini file
 - Change TableDir=c:\mt2000\samples to be your z:\mt2000\tables or m:\tables whichever you noted above.
 - Change ReportsDir=c:\mt2000\reports to match above with “reports” instead of “tables”
- Enter BDE Config from MUMS 2000 menu
 - Go to Paradox setting and change NET DIR to be same as noted above.
 - Click on a field below NET DIR before you exit so it knows to save the change
- Enter MUMS from your desktop and all should be OK.

ANOTHER ISSUE if you get a BDE error when trying to execute MUMS then do a right click on the MUMS Icon and change Properties and select Compatibility Mode and pick Windows 2000 or Windows XP.

If MUMS asks for upgrade database each time you enter MUMS, turn off UAC, under Control Panel, System & Security, Action Center, Change User Account Control.
